

TRANSPORTATION FOR MANSFIELD SENIORS

Low cost transportation is available for Mansfield seniors age 60 and older through GATRA, the Greater Attleboro Taunton Regional Transportation Authority. GATRA offers the citizens of Mansfield two types of transportation, Dial-A-Ride and the Mansfield Connection.



Dial-A-Ride is available for transportation in Mansfield according to the schedule established by the Council On Aging, published in the monthly newsletter, and hours of operation are 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday. **Seniors must first submit an application to GATRA and be accepted as riders in order to use the**

service. Applications are available at the Council On Aging or online at GATRA.org. *Dial-A-Ride is also available to disabled adults under age 60 who have filed an application with and have been accepted as eligible by GATRA. Applications for ADA ridership are available at GATRA.org.* Fares are \$1.25 one way within Mansfield if paying with cash, and \$1 one way with a ticket. Ten ride tickets may be purchased for \$10 at the Council On Aging Monday through Thursday from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM, and on Friday from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Round trip fares for out of Mansfield are \$5 per trip.

Short Distance Medical Transportation is available on the Dial-A-Ride according to the following schedule:

Foxboro and Plainville—Mondays and Wednesdays for appointments between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM (for a 1:00 PM return);

Attleboro—Tuesdays and Thursdays for appointments between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM (for a 1:00 PM return);

Norwood—Fridays for appointments between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM (for a 1:00 PM return).

Mansfield Connection is a GATRA transportation service for Mansfield community adults which shuttles riders from their homes to the train and from the train to their homes. One way fares are \$2.

All trips may be scheduled through Kim at Bill's Taxi by calling 1-800-529-8294. Bill's Taxi is contracted by GATRA to provide transportation services in Mansfield.
